PAUL...the audience will tell us when they want a change... when we can sense that we will change.

TM..how did you feel when you first came to london and started to get a following?

PAUL...its only really happened in the last few months really..

RICK..we wer'nt really giging enough in London to get a following.

TM..are you aiming at a particular audience?

PAUL...ayoung audience!!!!

TM..you are the write in theband, are you always under pressure to write new numbers?

PAUL..well we have just done an LP... i'm not trying to be flash, but its trying to find the time to write and rehearse..its the same with any band really...i'm not a prolific writer any way..imust write a song a month. I was talking to Joe from the Clash and he said the same..as long as the song is a good one..you could write ten songs and they would all be bad, when i do write i write quickly.

I thought of a quote the other day... its alright to knock the past you know the sixties..but why not take some of the good points and build on them.. there were some great points in the sixties that we are naever going to reach in the seventies....fuckin' mid seventies already.

TM do you try and write about your enviroment...

PAUL..i'm not sure what my enviroment i is..if i was just a kid who worked in a factory..and that was just life.....

TM..you were working recently..

PAUL..i always knaew that i'd ma ke it...ialways looked around in the clas s room..i new i was going to do somethingg ..i mean some cunt teacher called me thick and that,he's still going to be around in ten years..i'm going to be doing something else.....

It's nearly 4 months since I first wrote about the Stranglers-remember "Sideburns!" (you KNOW T.V. ads etc) Times have changed it seems-the Stranglers have moved on-each time I've seen them I've gone away thinking of the next time-see familiar faces-see the Finchley boys pogo on stage-"So Buddy GO!" The single was great but it lacked the ~~REST~~ of the ~~SET~~ wrapped around it-lots of people bought the single-lots of cool people knocked it in a big way-walk past their doors and whats playing on the cassette? Yeah GILL, whats the game??? sunglasses steamed up-and now the one-the LP-The cover is great-not just the same quick live shot with a track listing stuck on it end. Something to make you think- Hugh's got a tube coming out of his body and is holding hands with an old victorian doll-Jett just stands mysteriously. Daves-got a wooden cat in his lap-Jean-stands out-Both Dave and Jean have some weird make up on their faces.

The whole LP is amazing-I just leave the auto change on-period. The sound is like it is live-yet they've put in some other little bits that jump out at you..weird voices, riffs, drums cymbals eerie hovering sounds on the keyboards. So now a blow by blow account "Of the LP that is today -1977..... **SIDE ONE**"

RATTUS NORVEGICUS (P!!LP!!)

Goodbye Toulouse-winning Keyboards to open and the whole band burst in with Hugh on vocals.

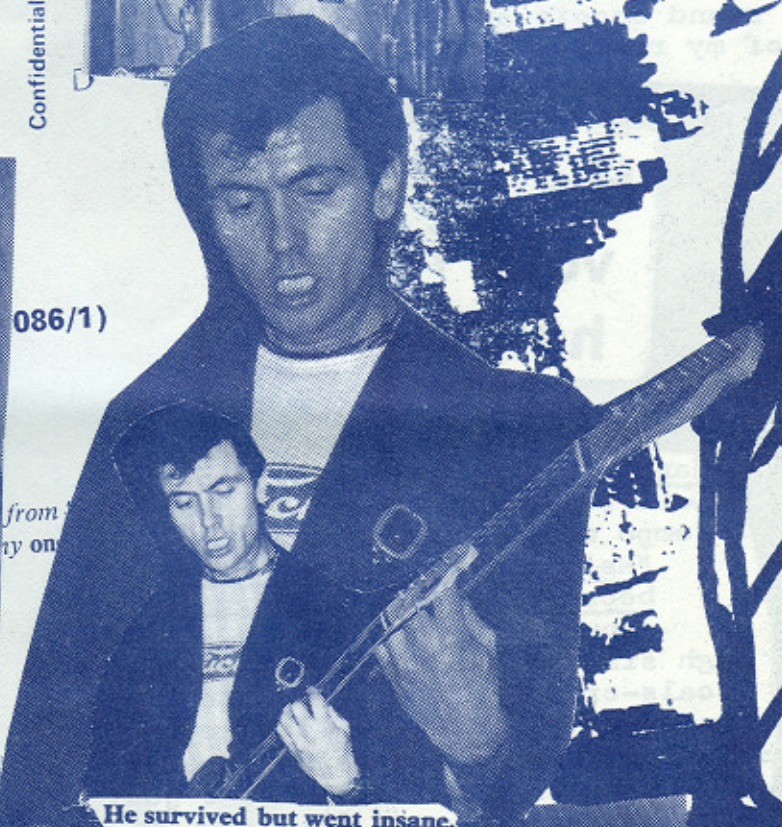

the whole audience walked out!
JETT..oh that was amazing...yea...well it was
in Purley..some sort of CONservative club
..over eight-teens night ,or something,when
we saw the public walking in dressed in
evening dress etc...we thought"...they are
not going to like us!2..we decided that we w
we'rnt going to compromise our act..
we were just going to play what we usually
played.....after all we had been booked
by someone who had plenty of time to see wha
our act was about...it was n't really off
offensive..it was that we could see that
these people were into less interesting music
than we were trying to create...to those
sort of people we would only gain respectabilit
when we appeared on the tele...so at the
begining of the act i went up to the mike
