London wanted to write songs about things that directly affected youth ... at this stage i mentioned what Paul Weller from the JAM had said to me some time before..that what they sung about was sort of Urban politics..London agreed that it was a good way to put what they were a about.

I spoke to Johnnie most of the time who is a good bloke...at the moment the main writing is comeing from Steve and Riff..although the others are now starting. Three months ago they started to rehearse and "argue" and then they went out on the road doing some supports and then the Stranglers tour came up...

As with most drummers these days johnnie has had a stint behind the skins of the Clash when they were looking for one...now apparently..the Clash did'nt like Johnnie too much..and Johnnie is 'nt to hot on them either...he reckons that they have sold out...for various reasons...anyway he calls himself RICH after the CLASH experiences.

"IT'S NOT THE AGE OF THE BODY..IT'S THE AGE OF THE MIND JOhnnie likes what the Pistols have done..they set the whole ball rolling but they are gone haveing do done their job..whats happening now is a third wave really..using what went before as a spring board.

TM..are you enjoying it?

Rock and roll is folk music and it should reflect whats going on around them..if you sing in English you dont communicate oh a folk level...andFOLK IS THE PEOPLE.

TM .. can we talk about today .. . TOp of the pops? JJ..yeagh..its a bit freaky...as you know we have to mi record the track this morning for the MU. and now we are mimeing it ... we wanted to be on TOTP however because it is a folk medium .. the

most accesable medium. and we wanted to communicate .. nevertheless we are involved in inverted snobbery TOTP is a light weight programme , and it's become 1 lightweight because i think that in recent years certain rock bands...thought that the singles market was too light weight. and so they didnt contribute to make it a broader scene...there is no reason why we shouldn't return to the excitement of the sixties in that respect. that raw live scene. when the single was supreme..thats what is good about a lot of the new bands...they are all writing potential singles so they might as welluse the singles medium to expre themselves, but you've got a problem now...we are meant to be mimeing..but no way are we that kind of band...imean we could do it seriously and properly....

TM...the fact that you and Hugh have swopped guitars is surley to show everyone ... what is going on ...? JJ.. right..its a sord of symbolic wink in to them ... as i see it we are being allowed to play ..

TM.. allowed being the word.....

JJ .. right ... we are being allowed to reach a larger audience..i'lllet that speak for itseff...although i can't take the programme seriously nonethe less. TM..after ht epresent tour are you setting your

sights on America?

JJ..we are certainly going to go to america..but i'm not"setting my sights on America",it's not a great ambition of any of us to woo America..

Punk Nock's future is very limited. Sometimes a piece of music canbe more powerful than words..the medium is still music....thats rock 'n' roll music.....






